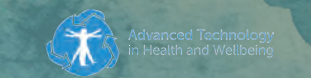
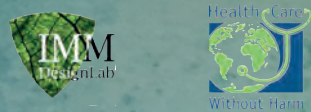
The One Health concept and the conference approach

As defined by One Health Commission, "One Health is an approach that recognizes that the health of people is closely connected to the health of animals and our shared environment". As well, in 2015, the Rockefeller Foundation and The Lancet defines Planetary health. Both concepts are rooted in the profound interdependence of human and natural systems and in the integration between planetary health and traditional environmental health.

The **One Health concept fosters a collaborative, multisectoral, trans-disciplinary and multi-level approach** to achieve optimal health and well-being outcomes recognizing the interconnections between people, animals, plants and their shared environment. As a result, cities find themselves at the interface of many scales of engagement, activity, policy-making and intervention when dealing with the causes, treatment, and recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.

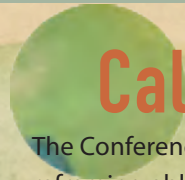
